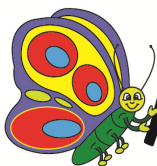

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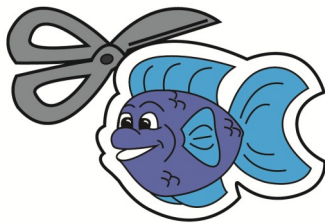

- 72 small metal washers

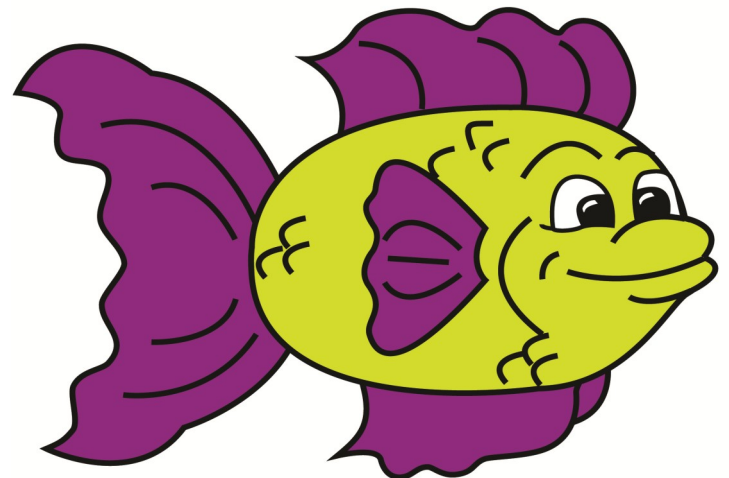
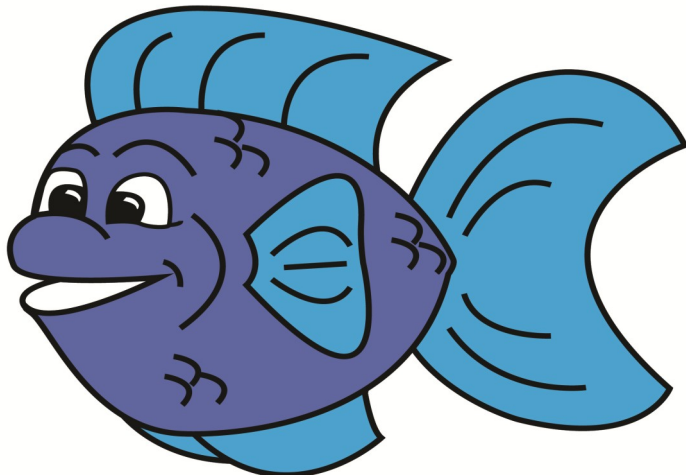
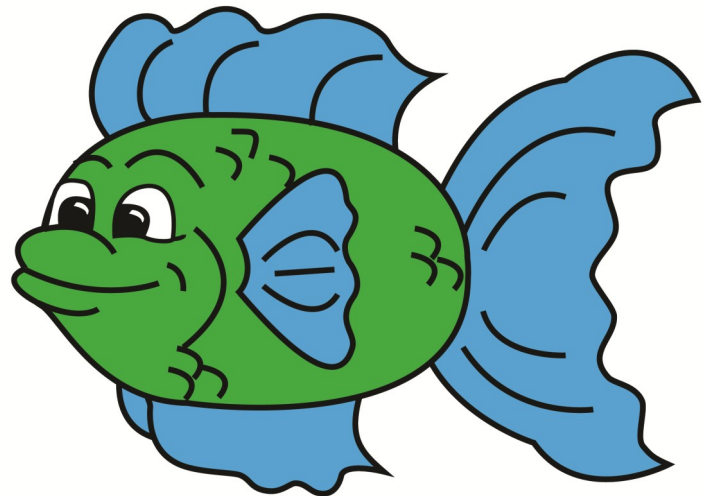
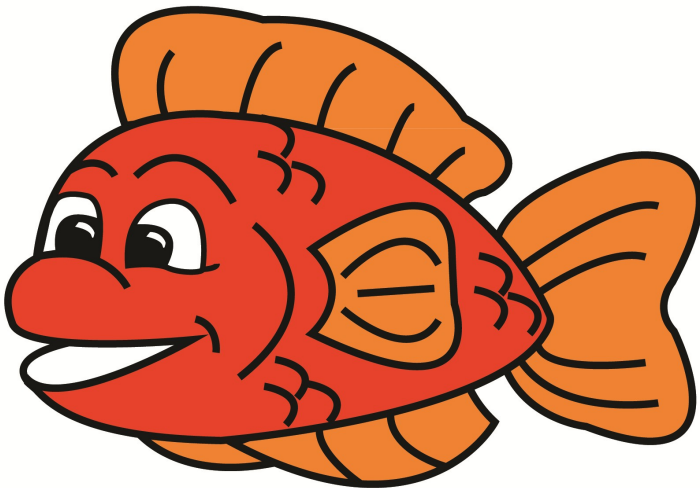
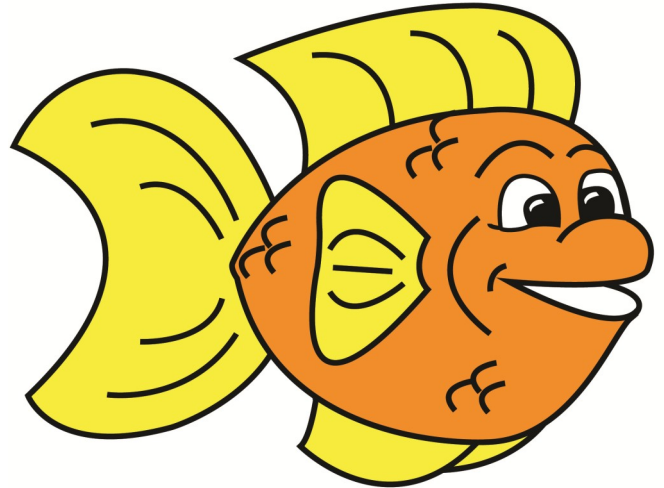
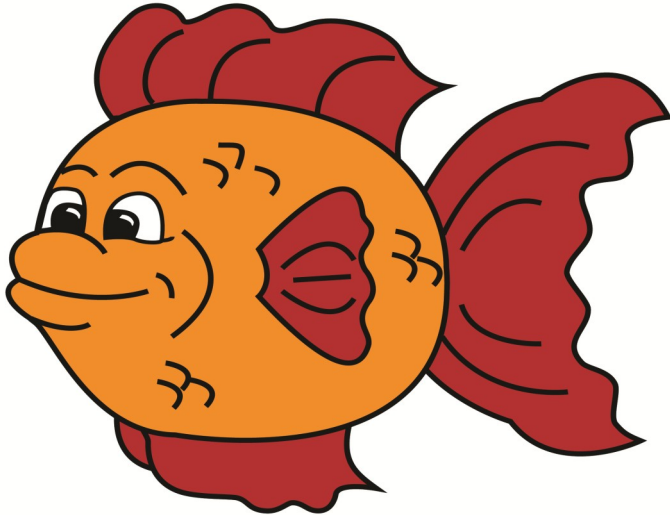
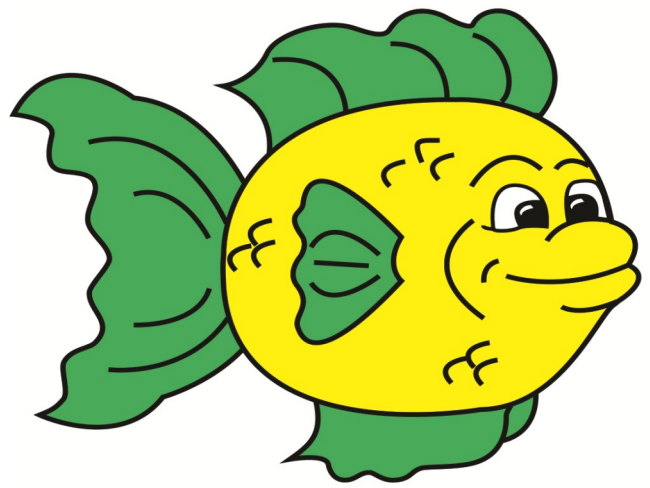
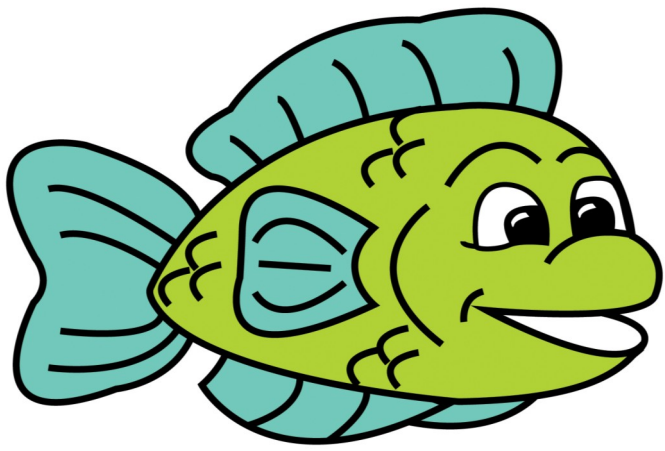
To Assemble Your Activity:

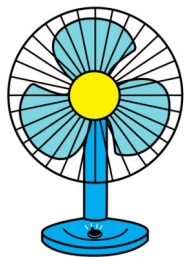
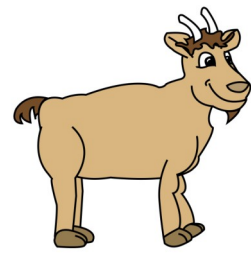
- Print the activity on cardstock. Be sure to print one-sided to two-sided

- Tie and glue the string on the end of the dowel rod

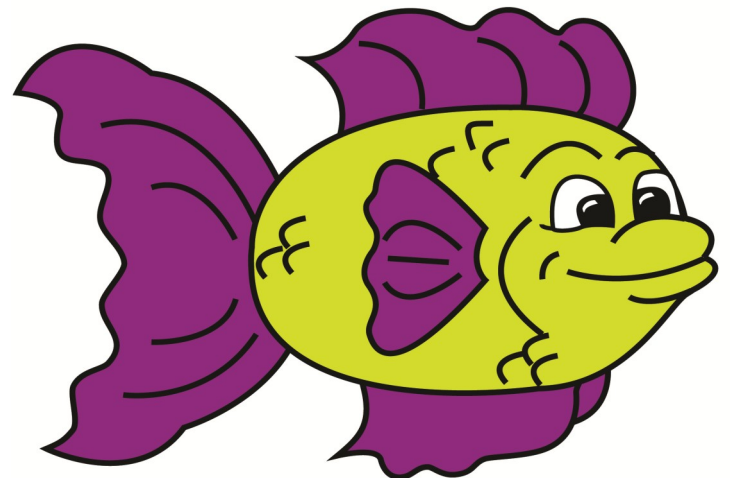
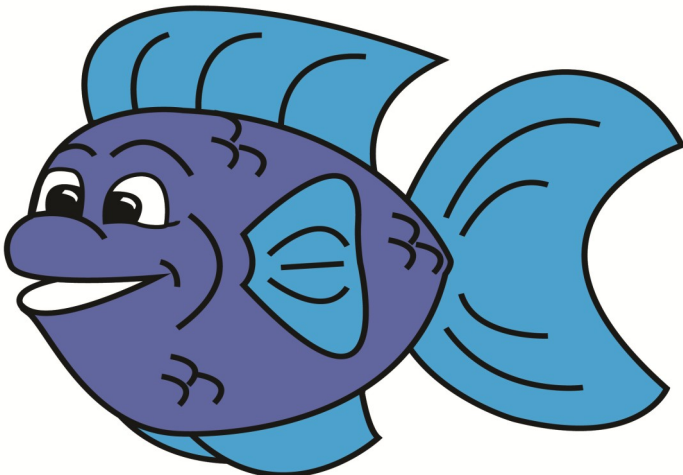
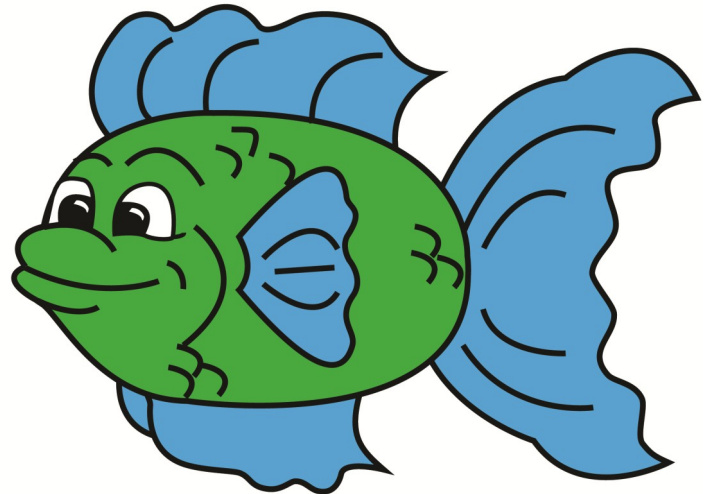
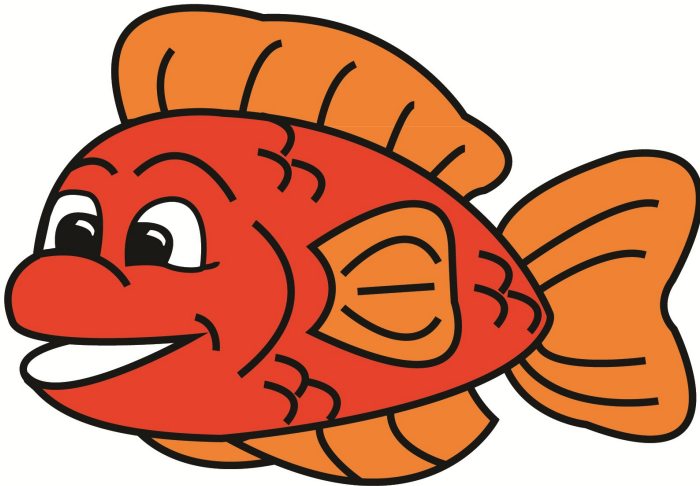
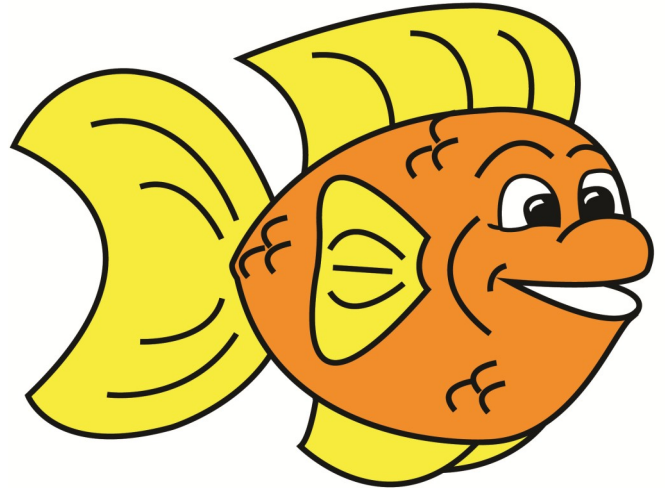
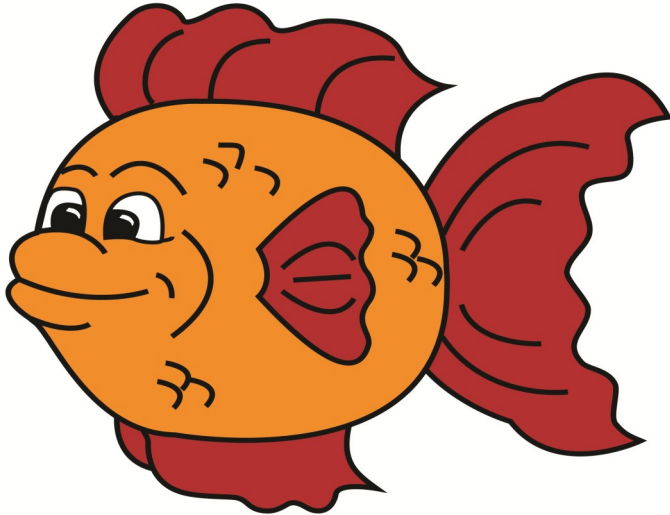
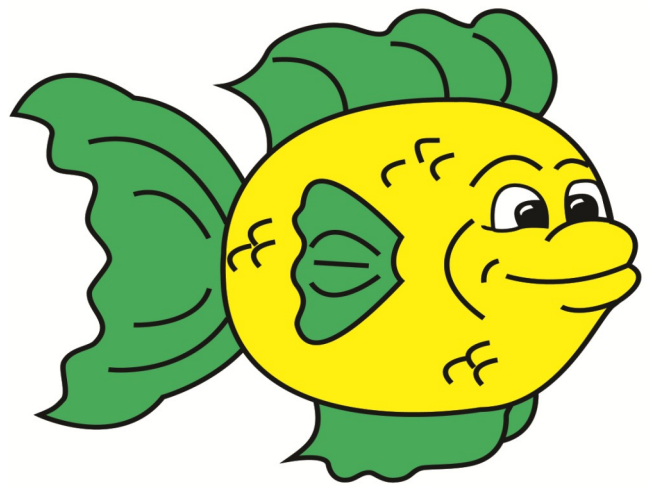
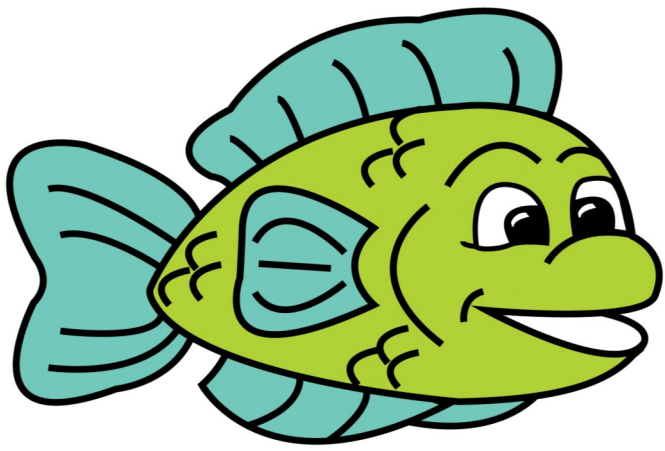


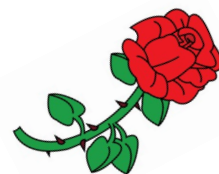
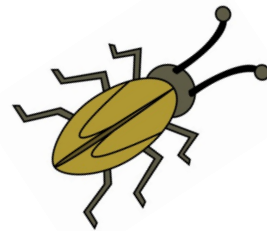
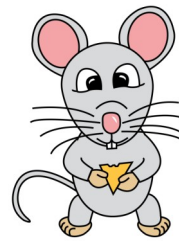
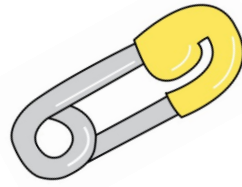
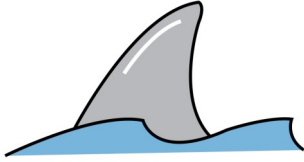
Teaching Directions:

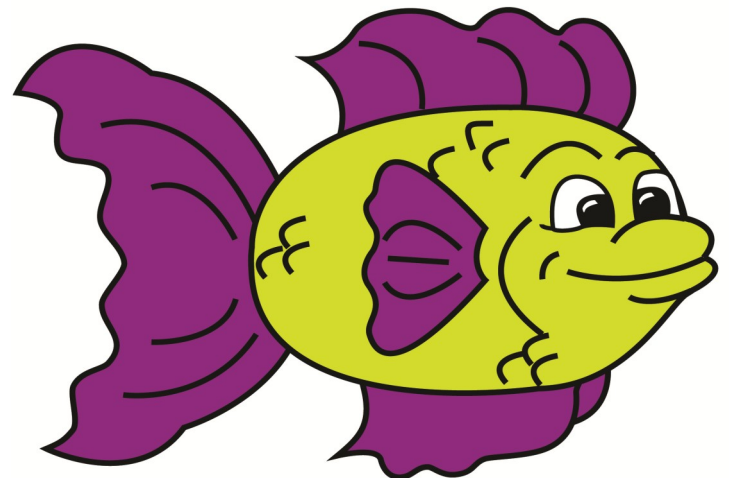
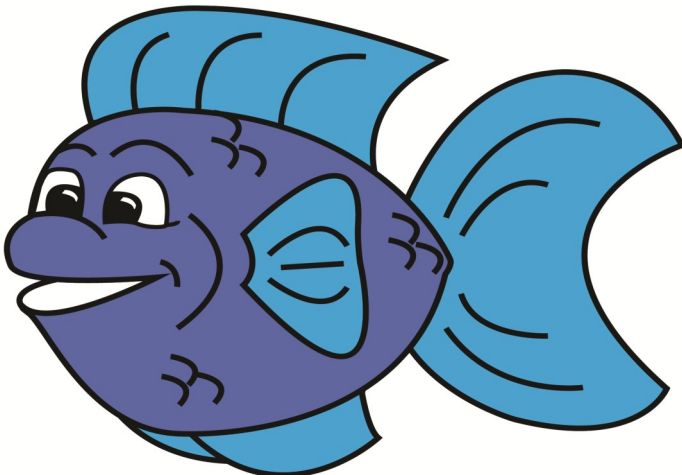
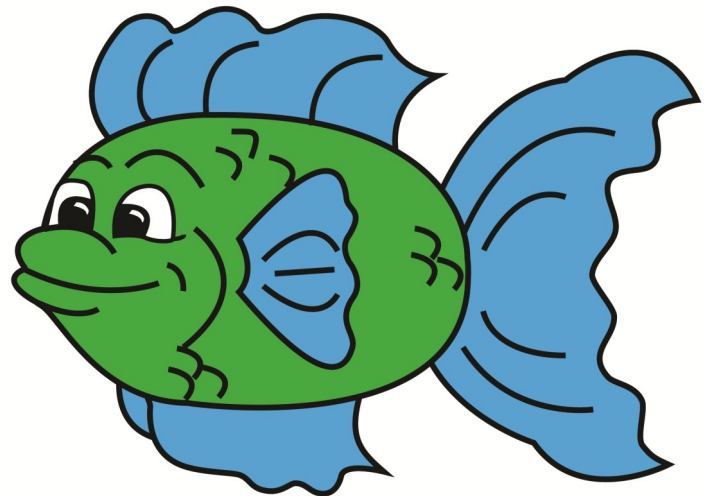
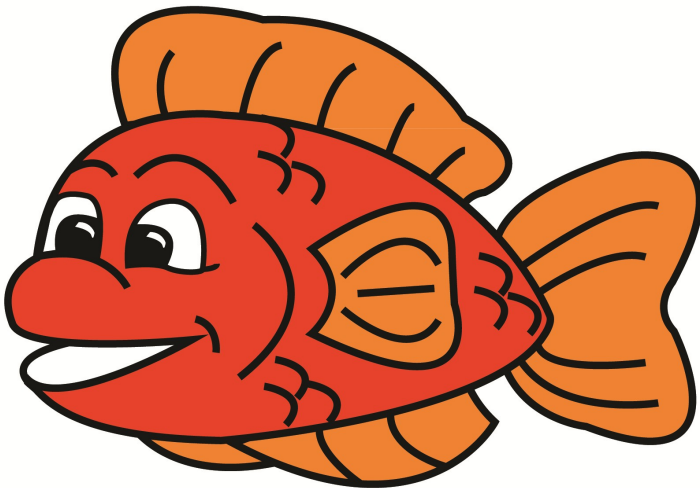
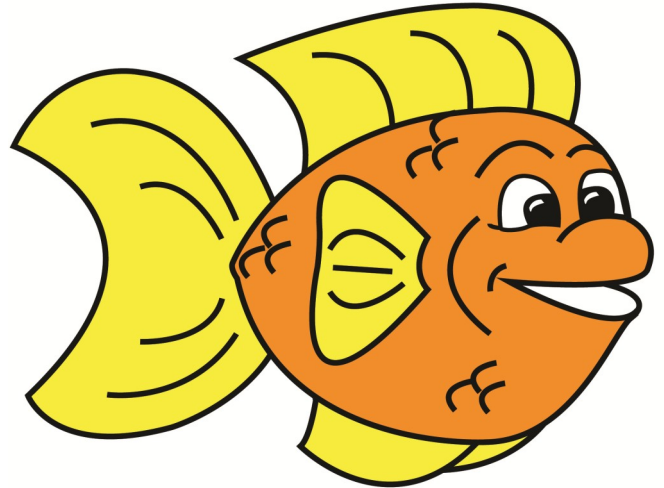
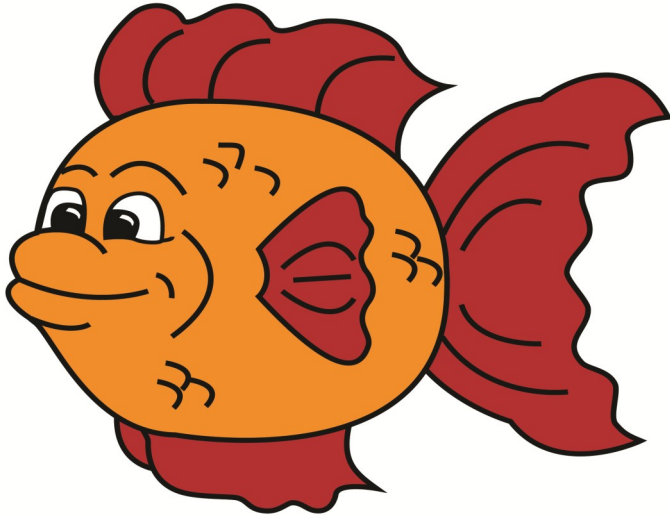
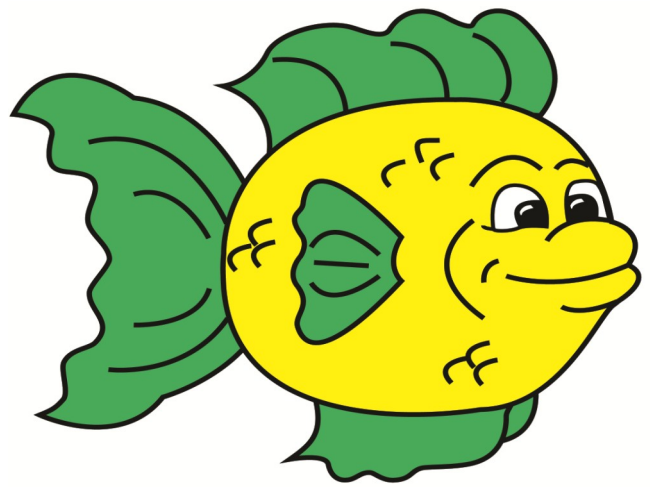
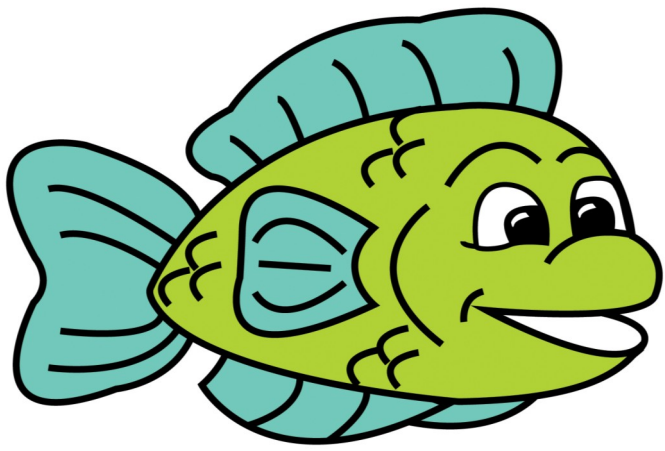
